CORRECTED FINAL JUDGMENT

On December 2, 2021, the above-numbered and styled cause was called for trial. The following parties appeared through counsel and announced ready for trial: Plaintiff Toro Rojo, Inc. d/b/a Action Trucking Company (“Action Trucking”) and Defendants Mulch Matters, Inc. and Prime Trees, Inc. d/b/a Mulch Matters, Inc. (collectively “Mulch Matters”). Defendants Mulch Matters, Inc. and Prime Trees, Inc. d/b/a Mulch Matters are jointly and severally liable for all of the amounts listed below.

The Jury was impaneled and sworn, and then heard arguments of counsel and the evidence of the parties. In response to the Court’s Charge, the Jury made findings that the Court received, filed, and entered of record in this cause of action. Action Trucking has filed a Renewed Motion for Entry of Judgment, and the Court now renders judgment as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff Action Trucking shall have and recover from Mulch Matters the following:

- a. **\$86,973.50 as damages, less a credit of \$12,520.00 for a total principal sum in the amount of \$74,453.50;**
- b. **Prejudgment interest at a rate of 5% per annum** from March 21, 2020 through **the date of judgment.**



- c. Attorney's fees of \$80,000.00
- d. Costs of court; and
- e. Post-judgment interest on all of the above at the statutory rate of 5% per annum.



This is a Final Judgment disposing
of ALL issues and ALL parties,
and ALL prior Interlocutory Orders
are hereby made final.
